

Certified Erosion and Sediment Control Lead (CESCL) Training

Do You Need a Construction Stormwater General Permit?

If your project disturbs over an acre of land or is in a subdivision, you probably do. Designed for residential builders, this training course explains the erosion process and how to apply and comply with the stormwater permit. The training consists of a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on field exercises and is recommended for anyone responsible for erosion and sediment control and treatment on a jobsite. Because the Department of Ecology requires the CESCL to be on-call or on-site at all times—companies should consider having more than one employee trained as a CESCL. Certification is valid for 3 years. *Attendees must bring a hard hat, safety vest and boots for the site visit.*

As a graduate of this course, you will be able to:

- Understand the importance of preventing erosion and the challenge of cleaning the turbid water.
- Apply the most current techniques for successfully managing erosion and sediment on construction sites.
- Comply with federal, state and local regulatory requirements for stormwater.
- Choose and correctly install mats, blankets, check dams, bonded fiber matrix, straw and other erosion control materials for specific site conditions.
- Take away a "tool box" of BMP's, as well as products that will help you respond effectively to a wide variety of site conditions.
